PAIRING AN INSERT OR BASKET WITH A MANTEL

This brochure has been designed to show the range of beautiful stone suites we offer. In order to provide you with an idea of how these might look in your home we have pictured a number of different fire options to complement the mantel.

However, please note that the mantel opening may need to be reduced in size by the addition of a slip set. This may be necessary in order for your fire and chimney to work correctly. Please refer to your retailer who will be able to advise on your particular circumstances.

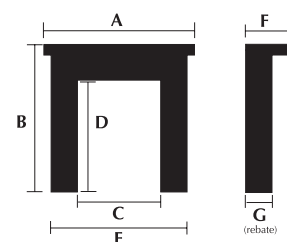
When selecting a basket to be used in a Class 2 situation, it is essential that a CORGI registered installer surveys your particular fireplace and chimney. Amongst all the other statutory checks that the CORGI registered installer must carry out, we advise you to ensure that your chosen basket fits fully underneath the flue and that the flue flow tests and spillage tests are carried out satisfactorily.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Please ensure that you have a survey carried out by your retailer before finally placing your order.

Air vents are not normally required for gas fires with a gas input rating of 6.9kW or less. Please ensure that your fitter carries out a spillage test during the commissioning process. Please ask your retailer for further information.

Unless otherwise specified the Natural Gas and LPG options are for decorative purposes only and should not be relied on as a heat source. Please note that when using an insert with solid fuel, its finish should be specified as black as non black surfaces change colour with heat.

IMPORTANT PRODUCT INFORMATION

Due to the manufacturing process all measurements are approximate, accurate to ±1/2" (±12mm) and may vary slightly. For the cast iron products, polished areas should remain greased or oiled with a non-flammable product until placed in a working fire situation. Non black products are not recommended for solid fuel fires as some discolouration may occur. Occasionally this process, which does not affect the serviceability of the product, may also occur with gas fires. If a slight change in colour will cause distress, it is strongly recommended that black products are selected.

The stone mantels pictured are manufactured from 100% natural material. As such the mantel you will purchase will be unique due to the very slight variations in fossil formation, veining and colour. This is one of the great attractions of 100% pure natural products.

All Gallery products should reach you in perfect condition, however please inspect goods prior to installation as no liability can be accepted for redecoration once installed. When burning Solid Fuel, a new Cast Iron Fireplace must be tempered by burning small fires initially. No responsibility can be accepted for heat damage where this procedure has not been followed. Colours shown are as accurate as the photographic and printing process will allow.

Some products may not be suitable for certain flue types. Before purchase we recommend you seek advice from a CORGI (Gas) or HETAS (Solid Fuel) registered installer. We reserve the right to alter design or withdraw product without prior notice. Designs and photographs shown are the design right and copy right of Capital Fireplaces Limited. Legal action will be taken against any infringement of these rights.

FIRE OPTIONS AVAILABLE

BASED ON THE TYPE OF CHIMNEY IN MY HOUSE

The heat source you can have within your chosen fireplace is dependent on the type of chimney you have and the size of the fire you choose.

This page is here to help identify what type of fire is appropriate for your circumstances. Firstly identify what type of chimney you have, select an insert and refer to the key at the bottom of this page to identify what fuel you can burn.

CLASS 1



Commonly in older houses, earlier than 1960. The Class 1 chimney is identifiable by 7" (180mm) or greater diameter flue. The existing chimney must be structurally sound, please check before the installation of a new fireplace.

CLASS 2



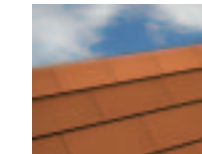
Either an older house where the existing chimney has been lined by a proprietary steel flue or a newer house with a steel flue built in. This chimney type is identifiable by a 5" (130 mm) diameter flue and a steel flue terminal.

PRE-CAST FLUE



Modern houses generally later than 1960 often have a pre-cast concrete chimney system, identifiable by a rectangular box section flue and a terminal, as illustrated in the picture.

NO CHIMNEY

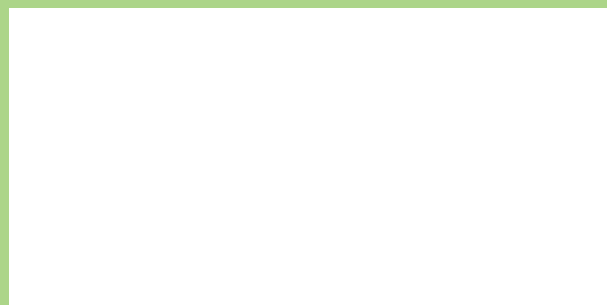


Modern houses often have no chimney, your options are either an electric fire, or a Powerflue system that can allow you to install a working gas fireplace. The Powerflue option must be installed on an outside wall with suitable room and height for the expulsion of gasses. Please check with your retailer to see if your circumstances are appropriate.

KEY

- SF - Solid fuel (coal and logs). Can only be used in a Class 1 chimney.
- NG - Natural gas.
- LPG - Liquid Propane Gas (LPG). Bottled gas used where natural gas is not available.
- REMOTE - Optional Infra-red remote control. Available for most Class 1 and 2 gas fires.
- SLIDE - Easy to use slide control.
- ELECTRIC WITH HEAT - Decorative electric fire with up to 2kW heat output.
- ELECTRIC NO HEAT - Decorative effect electric fire with no heat output.
- PICTURE FLAME - Decorative flame effect electric fire with 2kW heat output.
- POWER FLUE - Fan assisted gas fire for use where no flue is available. Must be fitted against an outside wall. Available for natural gas only.
